### Health and Safety Regulations Prodigy Dance Studios require to follow:

- To create a safe and healthy working environment with adequate control of health and safety risks.
- Ensuring all staff members of Prodigy Dance Studios communicate and consult with health and safety matters regarding themselves.
- All staff members of Prodigy Dance Studios should check the space we will be working in, so that it is in a suitable condition for a dance class, before partaking in the lesson.
- Make sure all students have a clear understanding of our health and safety procedures. Show all students the location and the procedure of fire safety.
- All incidents or injuries must be reported and noted the relevant staff member.
- All students must wear correct uniform at all times. Must be clothing that is easy to move/ dance in; bare feet or indoor trainers, only stud earrings and hair must be tied back.
- A fully qualified first aider must be present at all times.
- Staff/teachers must not carry out anything that could danger or harm the safety of learners.
- Any unidentified person seen on the premises must be reported to the Principal / Manager or office staff immediately.
